This amounts to AUD20,000 per school per year for three years. The impact in SU where we are the employing sponsor of chaplaincy (Qld, Tasmania & ACT) has been extraordinary and will see close to 700 chaplains managed by SU. There has been a need to reshape and extend the infrastructure of the organisation to cope with the growth, management & support of chaplaincy.

But these SU movements don't have growth in schools ministry on their own. In other places around the region there are new approaches and increasing opportunities to serve in schools. We rejoice in the open doors before us and value your prayers as you read the stories and pray through the requests we have given you.

The "107 Club" members have so far contributed \$1800 to assist in sending ministry resources to PI movements. We thank God for this help and plan to send the materials in the New Year.

Sam's appointment as PI Coordinator has been welcomed across the region and he has begun visiting and building connections and supporting the work. We thank you for your interest and prayers and commend you to our God of grace and this Christmas season and into the year ahead.

## Pacific Islands

- **Fiji**

Praise God for the 2007 SU Programmes in Fiji. Schools ministry is very strong and camping ministry is growing. Consideration is being given to move from a large national camp to regional camps to cope with the numbers and facilitate growth. The Council has added new members and is considering the best strategic approach to ministry in the future. Finances are under pressure and Sam is working with them to assist in building their financial capacity to meet their obligations and support the work. His visit was well received and they look forward to how the work can grow in the future.

- **Vanuatu**

A special feature of this past quarter has been the October 6<sup>th</sup> ISCF Training Day, focusing on preparing student teachers who will be going out to begin work in schools next year. A visiting team from South Australia were able to visit the islands of Santo, Tanna, Nguna and Pele and encourage the ministry of SU in schools and communities in those places. SU Vanuatu have also hosted a "Schoolies" group from NSW, who came to share in ministry in Port Vila. A wonderful answer to everyone's prayers has been the opening of a new Scripture Union office in Port Vila, on November 30<sup>th</sup>. - **Solomon Islands**

Happy New Year to all in the precious name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. As we begin this New Year, let us give God the Glory for what He has done for and through us in 2007. The SUSI National Council is now looking to replace our former National Coordinator, Mr. Philip Vahia. With the assistance of Sam Emery, the Council is looking at options on how this replacement could come about. The Council is also strengthening its relationship with SICA and SIFGA member churches. In its first effort, SU will provide to SICA member churches, Daily Bible Reading guidelines for its congregations' use. The churches would need to pay up-front a 50% deposit to meet the cost of freight and handling. The balance of money will be paid upon collection of same.

- **Papua New Guinea**

SUPNG staff and volunteers are thankful to the Lord for His grace to serve Him through the abilities we have for the Glory of His name. The Director, **Walo Vali**, paid visits to the Highlands and Islands Region two main centres, Goroka and Kavieng. Teachers are volunteering and are very enthusiastic and passionate about leading student to reach other students for Christ. Also in one of our biggest camps on KARKAR island, Madang about 1200 students gathered. How wonderful to see young people making commitment to Jesus to be the Lord of their lives. It is amazing to see the whole community owning the program - the parents, churches and local level government. These rural students make garden products to sell just to get them to the annual SU Camp. We thank God for Sam Emery's visit to PNG and look forward to working with him in the future. We are planning our 2008 National Camp and look forward to what we expect will be a great year.

- **Tonga**

- **Australian Capital Territory**

SUACT is growing rapidly, mainly through the expansion of school chaplaincy programs. In 2008 we will have chaplains working in 28 ACT government schools. The past year has provided many opportunities to uphold the name of Jesus Christ in the community as we

have promoted the value of school chaplaincy. There have also been new opportunities for mission in different regions of Canberra and a growing awareness of the need to meet non-Christians where they are in the community.

Staff turnover continues to be an issue with most of our staff new to their positions. This should include a change of director some time this year, but the timing is not yet clear. The role of Director is being replaced by a Chief Executive Officer to reflect the rapid growth in the organisation and the structural changes needed to manage a larger organisation.

- **New South Wales**

One of the really exciting success stories of 2007 was the addition of two Schools Ministry Trainees to the Sydney staff team. Throughout the year **Ali opdeVeigh** and **Alison Laird** were able to connect with hundreds of volunteers and encourage them in their vital ministry. Visiting lunch time groups, running activities and getting local prayer breakfasts started have been important elements of this relationship building process. Ali and Alison also had the privilege of joining 15 Year 12 students on the Schoolies Week in Vanuatu trip in November. The impact of having two full time schools ministry support workers has been powerful, with a significant increase in registered ISCF groups, and the introduction of several new ministry programs aimed at improving volunteer support and helping school students to grow in their maturity in Christ. The plan is to multiply the number of trainees in the coming years to have any even greater impact for Jesus throughout NSW state schools.

- **South Australia**

September and October saw the first steps of a new ministry emerge for SU South Australia. For some months, **Ian Roberts** had been working in partnership with Prison Fellowship Australia (SA) to develop a program of day events, camps and follow up for children of sentenced prisoners. The first event was held in September with 11 children attending a fun-filled day at "the Beachouse" fun park. Children were in tears at the end of the day not wanting to go home.

In October, the team took the children on camp to Wellington where they spent two full days on activities, making friends and having input on what God has to say about them and relationships. All the children had a really positive time and some significant changes began to emerge in a number of them in just those few days. Of course, these changes are not sustainable without ongoing follow up which is now being developed.

At the end of the camp, the children all took away a Bible by request. One camper was so excited that as soon as he saw his mother at the end of camp, he jumped up and said, "Hey Mum! I've got a book about Jesus Christ!" It is a great beginning to see these children growing in Christ.

- **Queensland**

On December 14, crowds of young people will swarm out of school doors and begin to celebrate the end of another year.

But even with school doors closed, many kids will still struggle with the crises that 21<sup>st</sup> century life throws at them. Enter SU Qld camps which teach kids about God's grace in a caring environment.

Over the past 75 years, SU Qld camps have become a long-standing tradition, with countless people beginning their spiritual journey at one of these events.

An SU Qld staff member and first-time camp leader was very moved by the changes he saw in campers' lives.

*SU Qld camps are a compact, spiritual explosion for kids, where they receive a real God-soaking. They want to return again because people accept and believe in them. .The summer*



of 2007-2008 will see 1,000 young people and 300 volunteer leaders benefit from the unique opportunities SU Qld camps offer.

We ask for your prayers and support for SU Qld's campers as they begin a life-changing summer experience.

- **Northern Territory**

The search is over! Scripture Union in the NT is very thankful and grateful to God that it has been able to appoint a new Director after years of being without a Director. The new Director is **Glen Simpkins** who would be known to many supporters of SU around Australia. The other highlight recently has been a successful AGM where the financial reporting is now up to date.
