THE PHOEBE BOOKS

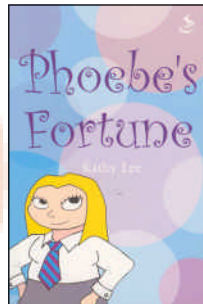

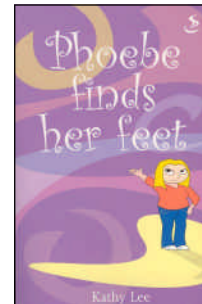

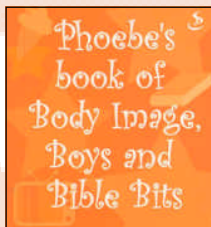

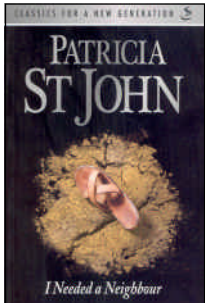
No Love Lost

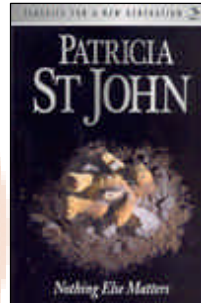


I Needed a Neighbour

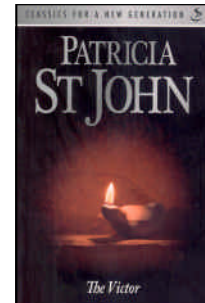


Nothing Else Matters

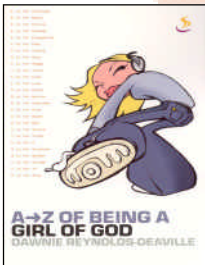

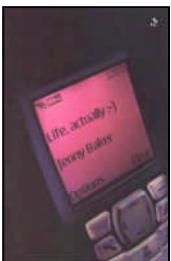

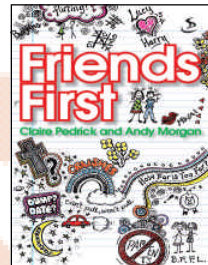
